Public Morality indicators climbed following the appointment of Army of God members to the Justice Ministry. Using detailed arrest lists, the Ministry increased enforcement of all Morality Code violations by 27% over the prior year. March of 2014 marked the first month with a 100% arrest-to-conviction rate for fetal murder, adultery, homosexuality, blasphemy, fornication, non-belief and other capital and Class X transgressions. Public Morality was also aided by the uploading of all arrest records into a national database, enabling analysts at the Ministry of Public Morals to more effectively weave Scripture into public education and add more focus to their after-school behavior modification programs.
